

Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K) Lottery Procedure

Residents of age appropriate students should submit an application by the date determined by the District. Preference for morning or afternoon classes will be requested.

Parents may attend the lottery. Student names will be written on morning or afternoon class boards as the lottery progresses. This will not represent your child's class in the fall. We will balance/redistribute the classes over the summer.

Available seats are filled as followed:

- All submitted names will be selected randomly.
- All children will be placed in their first choice, as long as those sessions remain open. Once a session has closed, and a second choice has been provided on the application, the child will be placed there. If no second choice was provided, the child will be placed on a wait list for their first choice. Every attempt will be made to accommodate a first choice, without guarantee.
- Twins, triplets, etc. are automatically enrolled if their sibling is chosen, if there is room in **that time** period.

PLEASE NOTE:

Children cannot occupy a space in a class while on the wait list for another. For example, a child cannot hold a seat in the afternoon class and be on the morning wait list.

Changes from one session to another will not be accepted.

You will be notified of the lottery results by mail. Results will not be given by telephone or email.

Applications received after the lottery will be placed on the wait list.

Registration materials will be mailed to you. Please follow directions for registration. Failure to make your appointment and complete your child's registration by the District's designated dates will result in forfeiture of your child's seat in Pre-K, with your child being placed on the wait list.
