- Students participate in improvisational exercises to build strong communication skills including how to make connections, become more decisive, increase teamwork, and understand the importance of establishing the who, what, and where

### **Dress Rehearsal**

Build upon the day's improvisational experiences, hone skills, and harness creativity.

- Students discover and overcome performance barriers through a practice session
- Students build performance relationships to create an atmosphere where their creativity and self-confidence flourishes
- Students apply humor, spontaneity, problem solving, and communication skills in a structured yet unpredictable learning environment

### **Show Time**

Create an original improvisational presentation for an audience of their peers.

- Students support one another as audience members and as performers
- Students apply knowledge, skills, and improvisational rules and tools to create an entertaining atmosphere that showcases teamwork and a cohesive story
