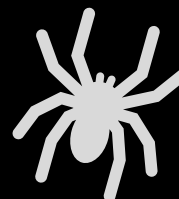

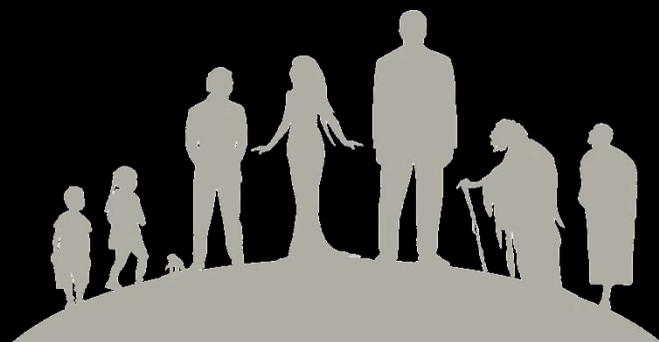

WEDNESDAY ADDAMS

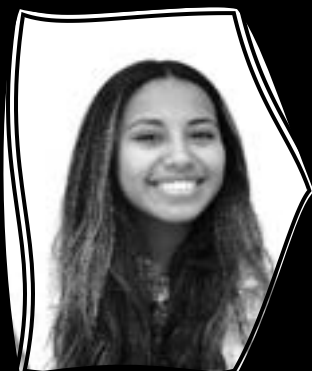
