# “Similes All About Me” Rubric (4 points)

- **You get 4 points if...**
  - all 4 sentences are simile sentences .
  - if all 4 sentences correctly show which thing you’re comparing yourself to.
  - if all 4 sentences show the quality you both have in common.
- **You get 3 points if...**
  - only 3 sentences are simile sentences.
  - if only 3 sentences correctly show which thing you’re comparing yourself to.
  - if only 3 sentences show the quality you both have in common.
- **You get 2 points if...**
  - only 2 sentences are simile sentences.
  - if only 2 sentences correctly show which thing you’re comparing yourself to.
  - if only 2 sentences show the quality you both have in common.
- **You get 1 point if...**
  - only 1 sentence is a simile sentence.
  - if only 1 sentence correctly shows which thing you’re comparing yourself to.
  - if only 1 sentence shows the quality you both have in common.

## **Similes All About Me!**

You will be making a simile poem about yourself. For each line of the poem, you will have to create a simile comparing a personality trait to something else.

### **Your poem page must have:**

- 1.** 5 similes. Make your simile follow “I am”.

Remember, these similes are about you!

**AND**

- 2.** You must use 2 “like” similes and 2 “as” similes.

You may choose how to phrase your 5<sup>th</sup> simile. Be creative! Be funny! Good writers use interesting and words to make their writing more exciting.

**AND**

- 3.** A picture that creatively represents the comparison you made between yourself and something else.
