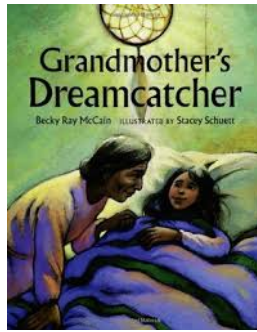


Family Literacy Night #5
