

Hello LCSD Families,

The COVID-19 infection rate continues to decrease in Erie County, which allows for the potential return of our LMS and LHS students to full-time in-person instruction that was not possible when our PreK - 6 students returned on Monday, April 26, 2021.

We will continue to monitor the level of COVID-19 transmission in preparation for the potential full reopening of in-person instruction for our students in grades 7-12. In our current learning model, students/families who selected the hybrid learning model for the second semester would transition to full, in-person instruction. Those 7-12 families who selected 100% remote learning for their child for the second semester will maintain that learning model.

We would appreciate your participation in a brief survey regarding the potential return to full-time instruction for students at the secondary level. As you complete the survey, please keep in mind that the final day of instruction for students in grades 7-12 is scheduled for Tuesday, June 22, 2021.
