African Americans

The Universal Negro Improvement Association founded by this person	
Well known for crusading against Lynching	
Believed African Americans had to become educated in order to be valuable members of a community	
Demanded full political rights and responsibilities for African Americans as well as an end to racial discrimination at Niagara Falls meeting	

Muckrakers

Described shocking graft and corrupt practices of urban political machines	
Wrote about how the railroad monopolies dominated in California	
Exposed the unsanitary conditions in Chicago's slaughterhouses	
Exposed the conditions of the slums through photos in the novel "How the Other Half Lives"	

Women

Founded Hull House where immigrants were introduced to American Culture and language	
Led the fight for birth control reform	
This person found that mentally ill people were being treated as criminals in prison	
Able to expose the corruption and injustice which broke up Standard Oil

Suffrage and Conservation

Head of the NAWSA; 19 th amendment ratified under her leadership	
Efforts led to a pattern for the national park system; conservationist	
Was arrested for trying to vote	
Wrote the Declaration of Sentiments	

Government and Politics

Referred to as a trust-buster who used the Sherman Anti-Trust to break up monopolies	
Passed reforms such as recall, initiative and referendum	
Ran Tammany Hall	
The Federal Reserve Act was passed during his presidency in order to maintain the amount of money in circulation
