**Subject: Non-Resident Students**

The Lancaster Central School District will not generally accept non-resident students on a tuition basis. For the specific circumstances enumerated herein, students will be accepted to the District's schools upon approval of the Superintendent of Schools.

**Future Students**

The children of families who have signed a contract with a completion date and/or proof of deposit/down payment to buy or build a residence in the District may be enrolled for the semester in which they expect to become residents. The family must also provide, in writing, the expected closing date for which they will become residents. All transportation is to be furnished by the parent or guardian while they live outside the District.

**Former Residents**

- a) If a student has completed grades 9, 10, and 11 in the Lancaster High School, is considered in good standing (i.e., academics, conduct, and attendance), and the parent or guardian moves from the District prior to the opening of school in September or during the school year, the student may complete grade 12 at Lancaster High at the request of the parent/guardian and with approval from the District. All transportation is to be furnished by the parent or guardian.
- b) If a student is enrolled in the Lancaster Central School District and the parent or guardian moves from the District on or after on or after March 1 of the school year, the student may continue through the remainder of that school year in the District at the request of the parent/guardian and with approval from the District. All transportation is to be furnished by the parent or guardian.
- c) Parents or guardians should be informed of this policy at the time they indicate a change in address, which is out of our District. Questions can be referred to the Registrar's Office.

**Foreign Exchange Students**

Only foreign students participating in a recognized Student Exchange Program may attend District schools.

Subject: Non-Resident Students (Cont'd.)

#### Reservation of Claims

Should a material misstatement of fact be made and relied upon by any administrator or the Board in admitting a non-resident, the Board shall be entitled to recover the cost of instruction in accordance with non-resident rates approved by the State Education Department for the time the student was not authorized to attend a school in the District from the person having made the misstatement or from a person in parental relation to the student.

#### Legal Residence

Parents who maintain more than one residence, but whose legal residence for the purposes of voting or filing income tax is within the District, may send their children to District schools.
